 - *Personal reference (two)*
4. Official Academic Transcripts *sent directly to* Cross-National Graduate School of Leadership from each college, university or seminary you have attended;
5. A "Relationships" paper (3 - 5 typed pages);
6. Please include a head and shoulders photograph of yourself with the application form.
7. Acceptable proof of English language skills (i.e. TOEFL scores of 550 minimum (paper), 213 (computer), 79 (Internet) – if English is not your primary language.
